The Early Childhood Division is pleased to announce the online Child Care Licensing System (CCL).

CCL has been in development since 2020 and is anticipated to go live later this year.

This modern, online system will move licensing applications, renewals, and other activities to a transparent, easy-to-use web-based system.



## Benefits of the Child Care Licensing System:

- Increased transparency will increase public, provider, and parent confidence in ND's licensing/regulatory function
- Decrease the manual effort and time involved in the licensing process
- Accurate count of current and active licensed and registered providers and more accurate reporting
- Required qualifications, such as background check memorandums and CPR/First Aid cards, are saved in the provider's online file
- Correction orders and inspection reports are available to the public
- Decrease the number of improperly licensed providers
