

CDA Track Training Bundles

--updated 6-3-2022

Individual Workforce Training Incentives are offered through the North Dakota Department of Human Services and available from mid-2022 through 2023 as part of the federal American Recovery Act. The Workforce Training Incentive is awarded to individuals who are **working** *toward* an Early Childhood credential such as the nationally recognized CDA Credential, or an Early Childhood degree.

Eligibility Requirements for all Workforce Training Incentives:

- Current membership in the Growing Futures Registry, with accurate and complete account information on file
- Completion of the 15-hour Getting Started course
- Career Pathways placement of Category A or higher
- Completion of eligible training within 36-months from date of application and/or college coursework within 6-months from date of application.
- Training/coursework is verified on the individual's Growing Futures training record.

Training Specific to CDA Credential Completion:

It is often difficult for individuals to select the right training in the right focus areas to complete the 120-hours of training required for the national CDA credentialing process. The following training has been "bundled" in packages of 18-20 hours in specific CDA areas to ensure that the training you complete will apply toward the CDA requirements in the right focus areas and for the right age groups.

When you complete one of the training bundles listed below, you may be eligible for a \$300 incentive. You may apply for additional Individual Training Incentives each time you complete another training bundle or one of the other eligible training/coursework options (see other eligible options below) up to a personal total of \$3600.

Instructions:

- Select a CDA track. Those working toward a Family/Group CDA may select either track.
- Choose the training bundle you're interested in completing.
- Complete all the training listed in the bundle. Each bundle is 18-20 hours of training. You'll find the courses listed below on the Growing Futures Training Calendar at <u>Growing Futures Event Search</u>
 - - All training required for a bundle must be completed within 36-months of the date you submit an application for a Workforce Training Incentive. If you've already completed some of the training in a bundle, complete the rest to be eligible for a Workforce Training Incentive.

Other Eligible Options for Workforce Training Incentive

In addition to the CDA Track Training Bundles listed above, individuals can complete other training or college coursework to earn a Workforce Training Incentive. Find eligible training <u>Growing Futures - Event Search (ndgrowingfutures.org)</u>

- E-Pyramid Birth to 5 Module \$300 for completion of the 18-hour training.
- **Aim4Excellence Modules 1-9** \$300 per module. May apply for multiple modules at a time.
- Early Childhood college coursework \$100 for completion of each Early Childhood one (1) semester credit completed within six (6) months from the date of application. Credit must have been earned with a letter grade of "C" or higher, and verified at the Growing Futures Registry with an official transcript sent directly to the Registry from the school that issued the credits. General education or unrelated courses do not qualify.
