



College and University Courses Accepted for Licensing and Growing Futures Career Pathways Placement

Implemented July 1, 2016 under the direction of the ND Department of Human Services. Special thanks to the ND Higher Education Consortium for their work on common course numbering for ECE degree programs (noted in the table as CC#).

Students completing a degree program at a college or university are required to take many courses and electives. However not all of those courses apply toward child care license renewal or placement on the Growing Futures Career Pathways. Only courses specific to the field of early care and education may be applied. The following courses offered at North Dakota colleges and universities have been approved by the ND Department of Human Services for annual child care license renewal. The Growing Futures Registry approves these same courses toward placement on the Growing Futures Career Pathways. To be accepted for both licensing and Pathways placement the course must appear on a student's official transcript with a letter grade of "C" or higher. PLEASE NOTE: A 1-semester credit course is equal to 15 clock hours. These courses are accepted at their full value (e.g. a 3-semester course counts as 45 clock hours)

For Career Pathways placement, the course must apply to the ND Core Competency Areas identified for each Career Pathways category. For example, to be applied toward Category B on the Career Pathways, the course must cover the Core Competency Areas of Learning Environments and Curriculum and/or Health, Safety, and Nutrition.
