

Classroom Assessment Scoring System® (CLASS®) Assessor-Provisional Endorsement Requirements

Updated 2-2022

The CLASS® Assessor conducts onsite observations for childcare and early education programs participating in Bright & Early, North Dakota's Quality Rating and Improvement System (QRIS). The CLASS® Assessor must maintain certification and reliability in the Infant, Toddler, and/or Pre-K CLASS® observation tool.

Growing Futures Membership

Must be a current member of the Growing Futures Registry

Education

Obtained a [Growing Futures Career Pathway](#) placement of Category E or Higher

Certification

Has a current Infant, Toddler and/or Pre-K CLASS® Reliability Certificate from Teachstone®.

Employment

Current employment by the state contracted vendor for QRIS Assessor services as verified on the individual's employment tab in Growing Futures.

Experience

A minimum of two (2) years of direct experience with children ages birth-8 years in a licensed early childhood program as verified on the individual's employment tab in Growing Futures.

Endorsement Duration

The provisional endorsement is valid for twelve (12) months with no more than two (2) renewals.

Renewal of the provisional endorsement is dependent on the individual showing verified progress toward the primary endorsement requirements, as defined by the individual's professional development plan and verified as applicable on the individual's Growing Futures Registry account.

Pre-Service Required Training

The following training must be verified on the individual's Growing Futures Learning Record as completed *prior to* application for the provisional endorsement.
